RE: Physical Address for 9-1-1 Database

Dear Resident and/or Business,

We are in the process of verifying physical addresses in Webb County to match its corresponding telephone number in the 9-1-1 database. Our records indicate that you have yet to register your location in order to obtain a physical address. The 10-digit telephone number we are referring to in need of a corresponding address can be found beneath the recipient's name on the envelope. The 9-1-1 database is comprised of all the telephone numbers in Webb County with their corresponding physical addresses. If you have telephone service, it is important that the physical address of the telephone is in the 9-1-1 database.

Your physical address is an essential element of 9-1-1 which helps route calls to the proper 9-1-1 call center and provides the call center pertinent information such as your physical location. Agencies such as police, fire, and ambulance service need a physical location so that they may properly respond to an emergency. Without a physical address it may take these responding entities longer to respond to an emergency.

We ask that you fill out the E911 Address Application and submit it to:
